

Color Palettes for About Face Presentations

Audrey Hepburn Night... 'Timeless Elegance'

In Arbonne's Travel Palette place 2 blushers and eye shadows:



Two blushers: Promise and Savvy

Eye shadows:

- Linen (warm base) & Shy (cool base)
 - o ***Note:** Substitute Demure and Suede as base eye shadow colors for **women of color**.
- Smudge (contour)
- Petal (overlay)
- Tulle (lid)



Other needed products for the night...

Concealer: Fair and Light

Foundations: Line Defiance or Mineral Powder Foundation

Note: Krista recommends the liquid foundation for your classes in 1C, 2W and 3N, and the Mineral Powder in 3N only. If you want to add more, the next two would be 6N and 7W liquid. If you are working with women of color, go into darker shades, having one each of a cool, neutral and warm. 15C is typically *not* used on a woman of color because they have warm skin tones.

Loose Powder: Light to Medium or the #1 (light)

Rejuvenating Mist: Awaken

Intelligence Personalizer

No Sun Intended Bronzing Powder

Eclipse eye pencil

Liquid Eye Liner

Black Lash Color mascara

Eye Pencil/Brows: Monroe pencil, Hepburn pencil

Brows: Blonde wax and Auburn wax

Lip pencils: Red Hot or Sienna for contour / Nice for fill

Lipsticks: Bravo or Decadent for contour (both will work for warm and cool)

Hula (warm) or Razzberry (cool) for medium color

Prep and Plump: Delicious to cover the lipsticks

Miscellaneous:

Cosmetic wedges, mascara wands, brush sanitizer, wet wipes, tissue, Cosmetic Brushes.

- These are colors that will work for most skin tones. To get started, consider one or two eye techniques that you would like to feature at your presentations, and then begin to assemble your travel Palettes.

V' Shape Night... 'Dare to be Beautiful'

In Arbonne's Travel Palette place 2 blushers and eye shadows:



Two blushers: Glow and Promise

Eye shadows:

- Linen (for warm tones) and Shy (for cool tones) to cover lid above and below eye
 - o **Note:** Substitute Demure and Suede as base eye shadow colors for women of color.
- Smudge and/or Inking (may use alone if dark enough or mix them for a darker effect until Arbonne comes out with a matte black shadow.
- Demure or Subtle (overlay color to cover contour shadow)
- Gilded (on lid)
- Tulle (starlight)

Concealer: Fair and Light

Foundations: Line Defiance or Mineral Powder Foundation (order both)

Loose Powder: Light to Medium or the #1 (light)

Rejuvenating Mist: Awaken

Intelligence Personalizer

No Sun Intended Bronzing Powder

Eclipse eye pencil

Liquid Eye Liner

Black Lash Color mascara

Eye Pencil/Brows: Monroe pencil, Hepburn pencil

Brows: Blonde wax and Auburn wax

Lip pencils: Kola or Naughty for contour / Nice for fill

Lipsticks: Earth or Decadent for contour (both will work for warm and cool)

Honey Do (warm) or Illusion (cool) for medium color

Sheer Shine: Sterling for center of lip or use Fair Concealer

Miscellaneous:

Cosmetic wedges, mascara wands, brush sanitizer, wet wipes, tissue, Cosmetic Brushes.

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- One travel Palette can typically be shared between two clients. Remember to wash and sanitizes your brush sets. You may mist Origins brush cleaner lightly, 3 times, over your Palettes (the shadows & blush) after each use. This will keep them sanitary.

Smokey Eye Night... 'Smokin Hot Night'

In Arbonne's Travel Palette place 2 blushers and eye shadows:



Two blushers: Flirt and Promise

Eye shadows:

- Linen (for warm tones) and Shy (for cool tones) to cover lid above and below eye
 - o **Note:** Substitute Demure and Suede as base eye shadow colors for women of color.
- Mix Smudge & Inkling (over the lid & into crease)
- Bewitched or Charade (overlay: either are great for contrast color over the Smudge & Inkling)

Loose Powder: Light to Medium or the #1 (light)
Rejuvenating Mist: Awaken
Intelligence Personalizer
No Sun Intended Bronzing Powder
Eclipse eye pencil
Liquid Eye Liner
Black Lash Color mascara
Eye Pencil/Brows: Monroe pencil, Hepburn pencil
Brows: Blonde wax and Auburn wax
Lip pencils: Kola or Naughty for contour / Nice for fill
Lipsticks: Earth or Decadent for contour (both will work for warm and cool)
Twig (warm) or Illusion (cool) for medium color
Sheer Shine: Use Fair Concealer in center of lip and then cover with Copper (warm) or Goldie (cool) Sheer Shine

Miscellaneous:

Cosmetic wedges, mascara wands, brush sanitizer, wet wipes, tissue, Cosmetic Brushes.

Tip: Promise blusher is in every palette.

Casual Eye Night... 'Simply Beautiful'

In Arbonne's Travel Palette place 2 blushers and eye shadows:



Two blushers: Purrr and Promise

Eye shadows:

- Linen (for warm tones) and Shy (for cool tones) to cover lid above and below the eye
 - o **Note:** Substitute Demure and Suede as base eye shadow colors for women of color.
- Tulle (for the inner corner of the eye)
- Smudge and/or Inking (may use alone if dark enough or mix them for a darker effect until Arbonne comes out with a matte black shadow.
- Diva (overlay to cover contour shadow)
- Heavenly (on lid)

Concealer: Fair and Light
Foundations: Line Defiance or Mineral Powder Foundation (order both)
Loose Powder: Light to Medium or the #1 (light)
Rejuvenating Mist: Awaken
Intelligence Personalizer
No Sun Intended Bronzing Powder
Eclipse eye pencil
Liquid Eye Liner
Black Lash Color mascara
Eye Pencil/Brows: Monroe pencil, Hepburn pencil
Brows: Blonde wax and Auburn wax
Lip pencils: Innocent or Naughty for contour / Nice for fill
Lipsticks: Espresso for contour (will work for warm and cool)
Honey Do (warm) or Tickled (cool) for medium color
Sheer Shine: Use Fair Concealer in center of lip and then cover with Copper (warm) or Goldie (cool) Sheer Shine

Miscellaneous:

Cosmetic wedges, mascara wands, brush sanitizer, wet wipes, tissue, Cosmetic Brushes.

Order what works best for you to get started. You may decide to fill up the tri-fold palette with the majority or most popular colors. Or, you may decide to fill one Travel Color Palette per eye technique (Audrey, V-Shaped, Casual, Smokey). See the Palette Map document to see what your palette would be filled with. It is a visual of what is listed above. See the note on page one regarding the foundation colors. You may add additional color products over time using your Host Promotion of \$100 for \$20 to be the most cost effective. The good news is that your color products will last a long time! You'll be able to do many color presentations before having to replace demonstration products.
